To request a change of plan or to resolve difficulties in registering, submit a Change of Plan at the front window of the Department. Failure to register according to plan by the emailed cutoff date will result in a reprimand from the department and the possible removal of all CSCI classes from your schedule.

Only CSCI courses are shown on this plan. You are personally responsible for registering for all non-CSCI courses, such as STAT 301 or 350, business courses for Applied majors, and math courses for Theoretical majors. It is also your responsibility to check your Degree Progress Report on MyNIU to verify that the catalog checked above aligns with the major/minor catalog R&R has assigned to you (listed a few lines after the start of your CS major requirements).
